



The most fundamental element of grassroots political action is participating in the electoral process. If you are **not** registered to vote, you make yourself a victim of -- rather than a player in -- the political process.

In order to influence elections and maximize our political power as REALTORS®, we must all register to vote and support REALTOR®-friendly candidates and REALTOR® issues on Election Day. If you're not *registered* to vote, you can't vote.

Voter registration is very simple.

How can I register to vote?

You can register by visiting Ohio's voter registration website - [click here](#). Download and complete your application and simply mail it in.

When must I register?

Ohio has a 30-day voter registration requirement.

Your properly completed and signed registration form must be **postmarked** or **received** by the 30th day before the election in which you wish to vote.

Where can I register to vote?

You may return your completed voter registration form by U.S. mail (or in person) to any of the following Boards of Elections for the county in which you reside:
